In 1769, Moses Thurston, a farmer, along with John Ladd started the settlement of Unity, NH. Soon, they were destitute of food. Moses supposedly walked barefooted to Walepole, NH, guided by spotted trees, and bought two bushels of corn, had it ground and then carried it twenty-five miles home on his back.

He said, he never felt happier than when his family sat down to that meal of pudding and maple molasses. He was a man of iron and will. He officiated in all of the town offices at different times.

In the French and Indian War, he was in Captain John Allcock's Company, Colonel Peter Gilman's Regiment, from Sep, 22 to Nov, 1755. He was a sergeant in a company of which Lieutenant- Colonel John Hart was captain. John Hart's Company was attached to Colonel Nathaniel Meserve's Regiment. Moses served in this Company from May 1, to Oct 12, 1756.

In an account of sums paid by Captain Samuel Leavitt, muster-master and paymaster of the forces raised out of Colonel Atkinson's Regiment for the Canada expedition in 1759, Moses enlisted Mar. 25, and received 3 pounds, 7 shillings and 6 pence.

He was in Captain Jacob Tilton's Company, Colonel John Goffe's Regiment from Apr. 26 to Nov. 27, 1860. It is uncertain how long Moses served as a private in the Revolutionary War, but he was a Second-Lieutenant in Company 5, Colonel Benjamin Bellow's Regiment, raised for the relief of Ticonderoga the last of June, 1777. But, as that fortress surrendered July. 7, 1777, they arrived only in time to increase the size of their retreating army. We have found two spellings for William Williamson's wife. The first was "Almedia" and the second was "Elmedia". We choose to use Almedia.

She moved to Akron, Ohio after her husband William Williamson passed away. She had two uncles, William "Bill Dad" Thurston and Grant Thurston, who lived in Akron, Ohio prior to Almedia moving.

She obtained a marriage license on March 1, 1894 in Mahaffey, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania. This was a duplicate marriage license. The original license was issued in Clearfield, Clearfield County, PA on 28 Feb 1894. She was married to William WILLIAMSON (son of Alexander WILLIAMSON and Mary HART) on March 3, 1894 in Mahaffey, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania - possibly. **William WILLIAMSON** was born on July 2, 1868 in New Monkland, Lanark, Scotland. He died on January 3, 1913 in Clearfield, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania. He was buried on January 5, 1913 in Boardman, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania. We have found two spellings for William Williamson's wife. The first was "Almedia" and the second was "Elmedia". We choose to use Almedia.

She moved to Akron, Ohio after her husband William Williamson passed away. She had two uncles, William "Bill Dad" Thurston and Grant Thurston, who lived in Akron, Ohio prior to Almedia moving.

She obtained a marriage license on March 1, 1894 in Mahaffey, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania. This was a duplicate marriage license. The original license was issued in Clearfield, Clearfield County, PA on 28 Feb 1894. She was married to William WILLIAMSON (son of Alexander WILLIAMSON and Mary HART) on March 3, 1894 in Mahaffey, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania - possibly. **William WILLIAMSON** was born on July 2, 1868 in New Monkland, Lanark, Scotland. He died on January 3, 1913 in Clearfield, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania. He was buried on January 5, 1913 in Boardman, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania. Mr. William Williamson is buried beside his wife Almedia Thurston. The undertaker's name was F. Leavy in Clearfield, PA.

### Comments:

We were told William Williamson, a coal miner, died because he refused to go to the doctor/hospital when he became ill. He supposedly wanted to spend Christmas with his family before seeking treatment. We have a copy of his death certificate dated December 8, 1998. The certificate number is 0246949.

The 1910 census places William and Almedia in Clearfield County. William Williamson and Almedia Thurston lived at 210 Prospect in Johnstown Pa. (during 1900 census). They were living in the same house with her brother Crans E. Thurston, his wife Jennie (unknown) and their children.

William and Almedia also lived in Boardman, St Benedict and Commodore (all in Pennsylvania).
